

Vending Machines to Automate Payment Handling

In the default configuration of the print management function, staff members assist patrons in making deposits into their paid printing accounts. If you would like to automate this process and allow patrons to make deposits without staff intervention, or if you would like to implement a pay-as-you-go printing flow, consider adding one or more vending machines to your system.

These durable, high-quality machines are designed for public use. Models that accept coins, coins and bills, magnetic stripe stored-value cards and/or consumer credit cards are all available. Additionally, models that vend both printing and photocopying are available. The machines come equipped with a free-standing base or pedestal that is ADA-compliant. The base can be removed for wall mounting.

A vending machine may be connected to any computer in the system, but it is typically connected to a patron self-service station or dedicated print release station, as this type of station will generally be available when a patron needs to make a deposit or release print jobs. When the station is configured to use a vending machine, additional options will automatically become available on the patron self-service menu.

The station to which the vending machine is connected can also be configured to print receipts for patrons after they make a deposit or pay for and release their print jobs. Any printer with a Windows printer driver may be used as a receipt printer.

A manufacturer's hardware warranty is included with the purchase of each machine. Extended warranties are available at the time of initial equipment purchase, giving you peace of mind well into the future.

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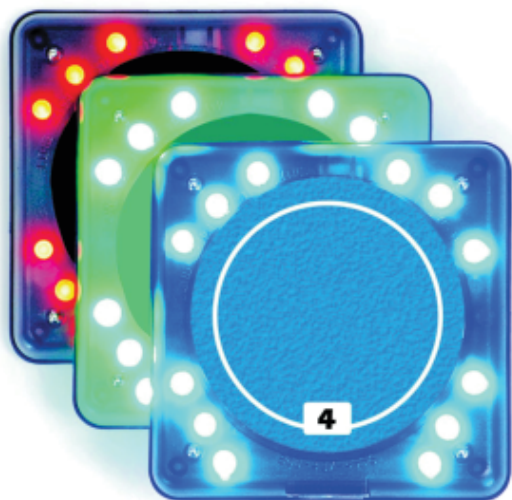
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Hardware Options

Wireless Paging Systems to Automate Computer Waiting Lists

This hardware option allows you to offer a unique service to your patrons – automatically paging them when their computer is ready. A single base station can serve all of the waiting lists within a building, and connects to any computer in the CASSIE System. You can place pager storage/charging stacks at each CASSIE self-service station and create a complete self-service solution.

An out-of-range function can be enabled to notify patrons when they are out of the base station's coverage area and to mitigate "accidental theft". If desired, you can also affix your anti-theft label or device onto (or within) each pager.



Alphanumeric and non-alphanumeric models are available in several colors to meet differing needs and budgets. The pagers measure 4" x 4" x 0.75". Each pager has a unique ID number, which patrons or staff can enter to associate the pager to a patron in the waiting list.

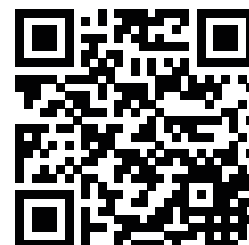
Alphanumeric models will actually tell the patron which computer is reserved for them. You can customize the message that is displayed when a page is received. Both models may be configured to vibrate and/or flash the lights when paged.

Pagers stack vertically atop one another on the charging base, resulting in a small footprint. The pagers are charging when they're not in use, so they're always ready when needed. The charging stacks can be combined to accommodate up to 60 pagers at a single service location.
